

**Day 1 Read Genesis 4:17-5:32.**

1. How would you compare the sons of Seth to the sons of Cain?
2. How is it that some children from the same parents can reject Jesus and others can believe and follow Him? ( John 7:5 and Matthew 10:34-39)

**Day 2 Read Genesis 6:1-8, Malachi 2:11-12, 1 Kings 11:1-9.**

1. As one possibility, read the word “Nephilim” as meaning men who have fallen away from God, “The sons of God” as men from the line of Seth, and the “daughters of men”, as women from the line of Cain. What is Genesis telling us happened to Godly men and what caused the world to be corrupted?
2. How is it possible for unbelieving women to pull you or other men away from God?

**Day 3 Read Genesis 6:9-12, Ezekiel 14:12-14, Hebrews 11:7, 2 Peter 2:4-10.**

1. How does the Bible describe Noah, and how does it describe the rest of humanity during that time in the world?
2. **Read Romans 3:21-25 and Psalm 1:1-2.** What allows you to stand righteously before God, and what enables you to walk blamelessly with God today?

**Day 4 Read Genesis 6:13-22.**

1. How does this text describe God’s response to the moral conditions of humanity at that time?
2. **Read Matthew 24:36-44.** How does Jesus validate the historical account of Noah, and what is the message he wants us to learn from these Biblical accounts?
